CAPE Project

The CAPE project aims to bring together best practice and experience from nine partners in eight different European countries (Poland, Netherlands, Spain, Italy, Portugal, Hungary, Romania and Cyprus) in order to develop a set of training tools and resources that can be utilized by vocational education teachers and trainers with the aim of embedding career management skills into their teaching programme.

The emphasis will be on developing targeted tools and resources that can help Vocational Education and Training (VET) teachers and trainers in how to improve links with employers and careers advice and guidance given to young people at risk of Early School Learning (ESL).

In addition, CAPE aims to bring together good practices in employer engagement from across Europe and through the establishment of employer forums and networks, and through the encouragement of VET providers and second chance schools for improving dialogue with enterprises.
