

What does the C-TEST project do?

The project educates both students and employees on new topics such as clean technologies and sustainability and how to integrate this knowledge into their working life.

Results

The learning materials C-TEST offers are based on the RESNET materials developed by the Slovakian University of Agriculture. The materials will be adapted and completed to fit the training needs of both students and employees across various countries. The main results of C-TEST are an online course, a manual for green VET colleges to set up a Training Day for students at a company, and tools for connecting alumni (employees) to school.

Topics established

The project partners met in March at the University of Agriculture in Nitra, Slovakia to discuss the RESNET materials. With the feedback of both VET teachers and SME managers in mind, the partners entered a brainstorm on the topics and content for the C-TEST online course. C-TEST will deliver 5 modules on Renewable Energy and add 3 related modules in support:

- 1 Solar Energy
- 2 Wind Energy
- 3 Water Energy
- 4 Biomass Energy
- 5 Geothermal Energy
- 6 Waste Management & Recycling
- 7 Energy Efficiency
- 8 Environmental Awareness

All topics will be supported by videos and self-assessment questions in national language.

Next meeting: Ireland

At the next consortium meeting in September all content of the 8 modules will be presented and discussed. Upon agreement the partners will then develop the support materials such as case studies and learning activities. The full online course will be available in 2014 for testing and implementation.



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
